The \$400 Gwendolyn Ray Danforth Scholarship was awarded to Ian Wallace. This year there were two recipients of the Richard J. ### Information Pertinent to Attendance at the Dance at the Waypoint Center:

**THERE WILL BE NO LEAVING AND RETURNING TO THE WAYPOINT CENTER DANCE.**

#### CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

A licensed cash bar will be provided by Donovan's. This event will be conducted under the Vermont state liquor laws and regulations. Absolutely no beverages may be brought into the dance. Everyone will be checked at the door. If you attempt to bring in a beverage of any kind, it will be confiscated. If you are found to be in possession of any beverage at the dance, not provided by the bar or caterer, you will be asked to leave the dance. You must be 21 years of age in order to consume alcoholic beverages. Everyone entering the dance will be asked to show a **valid ID** and will receive a wristband indicating whether they are over or under the age of 21. This wristband **MUST BE WORN** throughout the dance. Any minor who is found to be consuming an alcoholic beverage and anyone providing alcohol to a minor will be escorted out of the dance and will be subject to arrest. Either behavior **WILL** result in the bar being closed down. **NO BACKPACKS OR OVERSIZED BAGS ALLOWED AND ALL BAGS ARE SUBJECT TO BE SEARCHED**

**NEW THIS YEAR, ALCOHOL WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED IN A DESIGNATED, OVER 21, ROPED OFF AREA.**

#### SECURITY

The Bellows Falls Police Department will provide security for the dance at the Waypoint Center. They will ensure that all attending this dance will have a pleasant experience. Those who do not conduct themselves according to the rules set forth by the Alumni Association and Vermont state law will be removed from the dance. You may not leave the Waypoint area with any alcoholic beverages. Once you have left the confines of the Waypoint Center, you will be subject to the Village Open Bottle Ordinance and subject to arrest.

#### PARKING FOR THE ALUMNI DANCES

**Please do not park or block access to any private, business or personal property!** We strongly encourage everyone who can, to walk to the dances. This will free up parking spaces for those who cannot walk. It is also a great way to stay safe. The Alumni Association encourages the use of designated drivers. **NO PARKING** will be allowed on Canal Street. Any cars in violation of this will be towed at the owner's expense. If you drive to the Waypoint Dance, for the safety of those walking, please enter via Canal Street and exit via Island Street (past the railroad station and Robertson Paper) only.
